1.	viewpoint	<i>A viewpoint</i> is a way of thinking about something.
2.	surveyed	To have <i>surveyed</i> something is to have looked over its parts and features.
3.	advantages	<i>Advantages</i> are skills or situations in one's favor.
4.	previously	Something happened <i>previously</i> if it happened before another event.
5.	legendary	Something <i>legendary</i> is famous. <i>Legendary</i> people and places have usually been famous for a long time.
6.	retreat	To <i>retreat</i> is to withdraw from an attack.
7.	persuade	To <i>persuade</i> is to convince someone to do or believe something.
8.	aspects	<i>Aspects</i> are various parts of a whole.
9.	rural	Something <i>rural</i> is in the countryside.
10.	organize	To <i>organize</i> is to arrange things according to a system.
